TUITION & FEES POLICY:

Simplified Tuition

We have adopted a much simpler pricing structure in order to make classical education affordable to Christians dedicated to living out the gospel. The cost to attend CDA full time will be:

- 1. Low Tuition of \$5,640/student
- 2. A 10% Family Income Cap, after the 1st child, based on your Adjusted Gross Income

Tuition Adjustment

Coram Deo Academy is a ministry that assures an excellent, affordable, gospel-centered, and classical education. Our ability to pay teachers a fair wage is dependent upon families, partners, and churches that are willing to make sacrifices. The primary means of funding is provided through tuition and gifts. We encourage that those applying for a tuition adjustment to be willing to make lifestyle choices and sacrifices. We also ask those receiving a tuition adjustment to volunteer/serve the school in whatever capacity they are able.

Other Financial Obligations:

Registration (Non-Refundable):

Registration (after February 29): \$200 per child (Registration fees must be submitted at the time of interview).

New Student Entrance Exam or Transcript Review (Non-Refundable):

\$50 per student

In order for CDA to place <u>new</u> students in the correct grade, we require an entrance exam/transcript review administered by one of our staff. (Testing fees must be submitted at the time of testing/transcript review)

Student Fee (Non-Refundable in most cases):

\$720 per student K-12

The Student Fee will cover these items for the entire year:

- Curriculum
- Student Supplies
- Classroom Supplies
- PE fee
- Scheduled Field Trips

Billing Cycle:

- The billing cycle for will be July 1 to June 1. Your first tuition invoice for academic year will be issued July 1. The first tuition payment will be due July 1 and on the first of every month thereafter. You will receive statements through email each month to remind you of your payments.
- Your tuition will be calculated based on our Simplified Tuition schedule stated above. The final figure will then be divided by 12 and that will be your monthly tuition payment. (<u>Adjustments will be made when enrollment occurs after July 1</u>)

Early withdrawal of student(s) and refunds:

Student Testing and Registration Fees:

As stated above, these fees are non-refundable.

Supply & Activity (S&A) Fee and Tuition Paid:

If your student(s) is/are withdrawn <u>before</u> school commences, you will receive a refund for the S&A Fee and tuition.

If your student(s) is/are withdrawn <u>after</u> school commences, you will not receive a refund for the S&A Fee but will receive a pro-rated tuition refund. Any unpaid S&A Fee amount becomes due at the time of withdrawal.

Since we budget according to the number of students enrolled, upon payment of the registration fee, you are agreeing to pay all non-refundable fees for all of your students.

Fees that have been spread over the course of the year will become due upon the withdrawal of a student or students if this occurs after school commences for the year.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

The statement of faith adopted by the <u>Coram Deo Academy Education Association</u> is limited to primary Christian doctrine, which is considered to be central to all Christian denominations, and which sets Protestant Christianity apart from other faiths. For our purposes, a Christian is one who has heard the word of truth, Gospel (Col. 1:5), as summarized in the statement below, and who has responded to that message in genuine repentance and faith. He confesses with his mouth and believes in his heart that Jesus is Lord, that He died for his sins, and that God raised Him from the dead (Rom.10:9,10).

The following statement of faith is taken directly from the <u>Coram Deo Academy Education Association</u> By-Laws:

- 1. We believe the Bible alone to be the word of God, the ultimate and infallible authority for faith and practice.
- 2. We believe that there is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. He is omnipotent, omniscient, and omnipresent.
- 3. We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory.
- 4. We believe that, for the salvation of lost and sinful men, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely necessary.
- 5. We believe that salvation is by grace through faith alone.
- 6. We believe that faith without works is dead.
- 7. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life.
- 8. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved to the resurrection of life and they that are lost to the resurrection of damnation.
- 9. We believe in the spiritual unity of all believers in our Lord Jesus Christ.

As a charter member of the Association of Classical, Christian Schools (ACCS), <u>Coram Deo Academy</u> also subscribes to the ACCS statement of faith, which is found in that association's by-laws (essentially the first two chapters of the Westminster Confession of Faith).

ADMISSIONS POLICY

Coram Deo Academy strives to provide students with a quality learning environment, and we strive to ensure that our students meet standards of learning and conduct, above and beyond what other students are held to. Our worldview demands that we protect our children from the influences of evil that surround us culturally until such a time as we have trained them up to resist and fight this evil on their own. Therefore, we wish to maintain a safe and secure school to serve as the training grounds for our children, so that having received their training they may one day leave that security and be able to capably fight the good fight against the forces of darkness in this world, and be a blessing to society by their godly walk with the Lord.

The first basic requirement for admission to Coram Deo Academy is that the parents of students are members in good standing of a Bible-believing church. Exceptions to this requirement will only be handled on a case-by-case basis. We wish to spread the Gospel through education to all ends of the earth, and so we do allow for exceptions, but we do not wish to do this at the expense of your children's education, which is our first priority.

The second basic requirement is that parents have a good understanding of Classical Christian education and are fully committed to support the mission and vision of Coram Deo Academy.

Families that are new to Coram Deo Academy will be required to complete an interview with the Principal after submitting their enrollment form (the Principal will contact these families to schedule a time to meet). Returning families are not required to attend an interview, but may optionally request one if they so desire.

POLICY ON DISCRIMINATION
